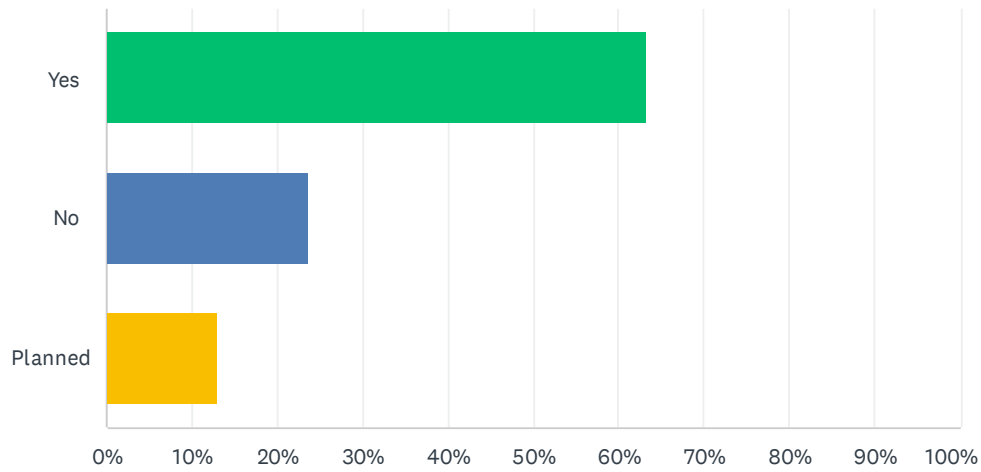


Q1 Do you have rooftop solar?

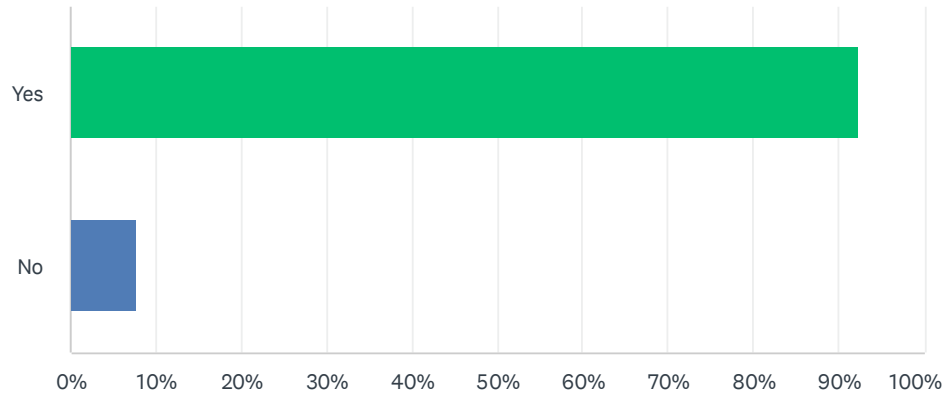

Q2 Do you export excess solar energy to the grid and get a credit on your electricity bill?

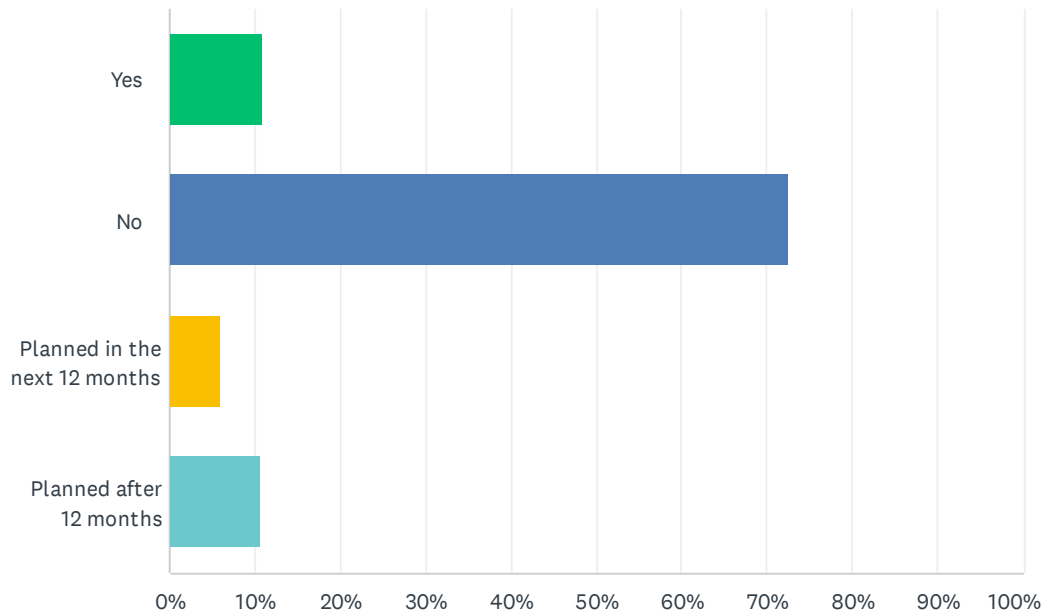

Q3 Do you have battery storage on your property?

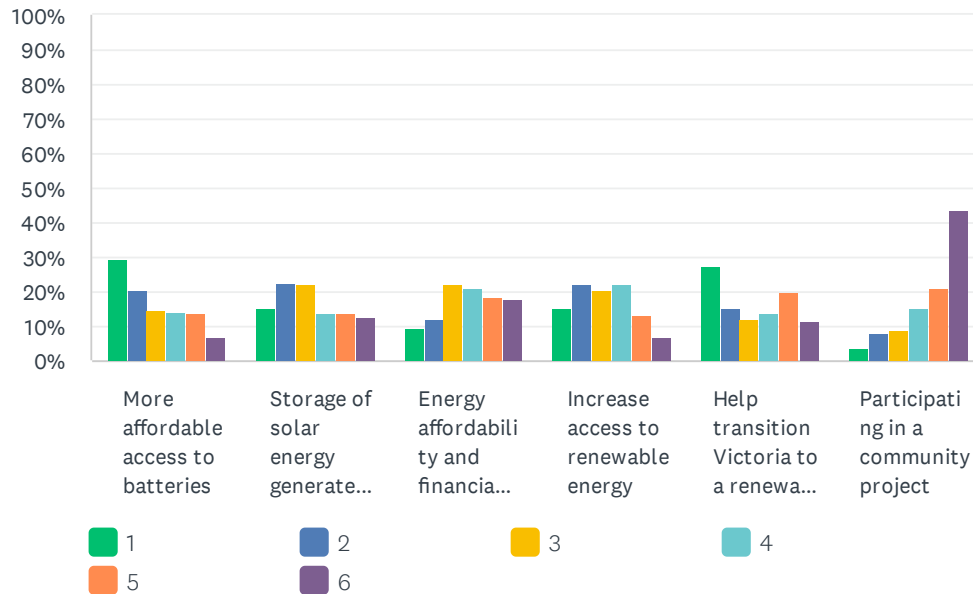

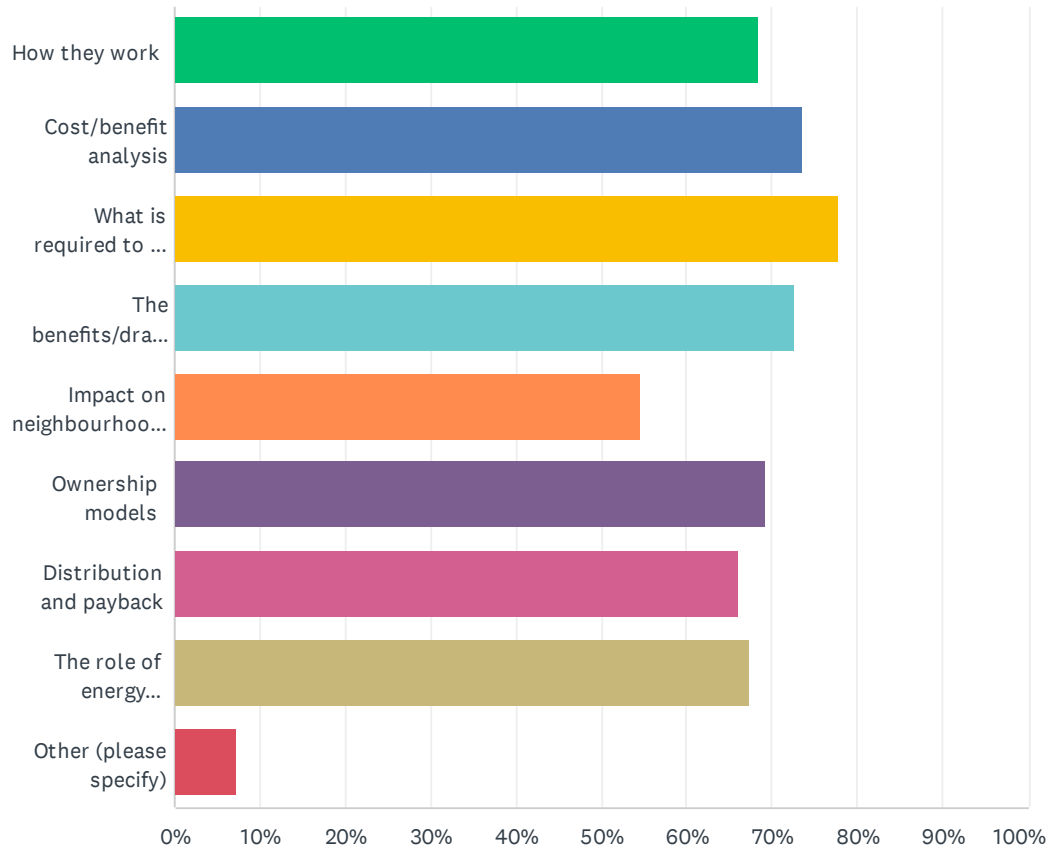

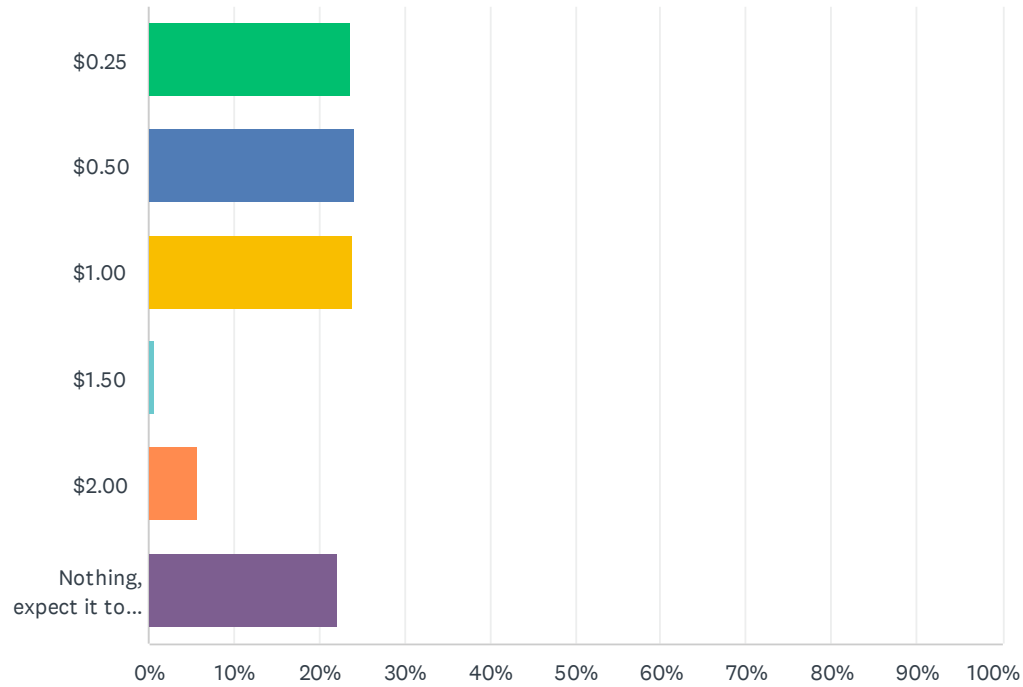

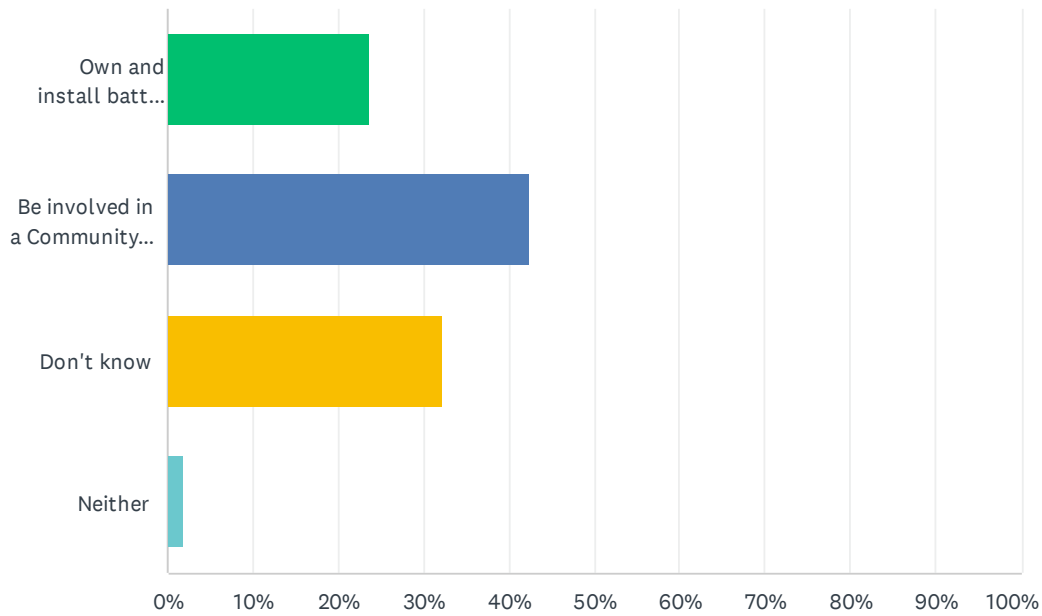

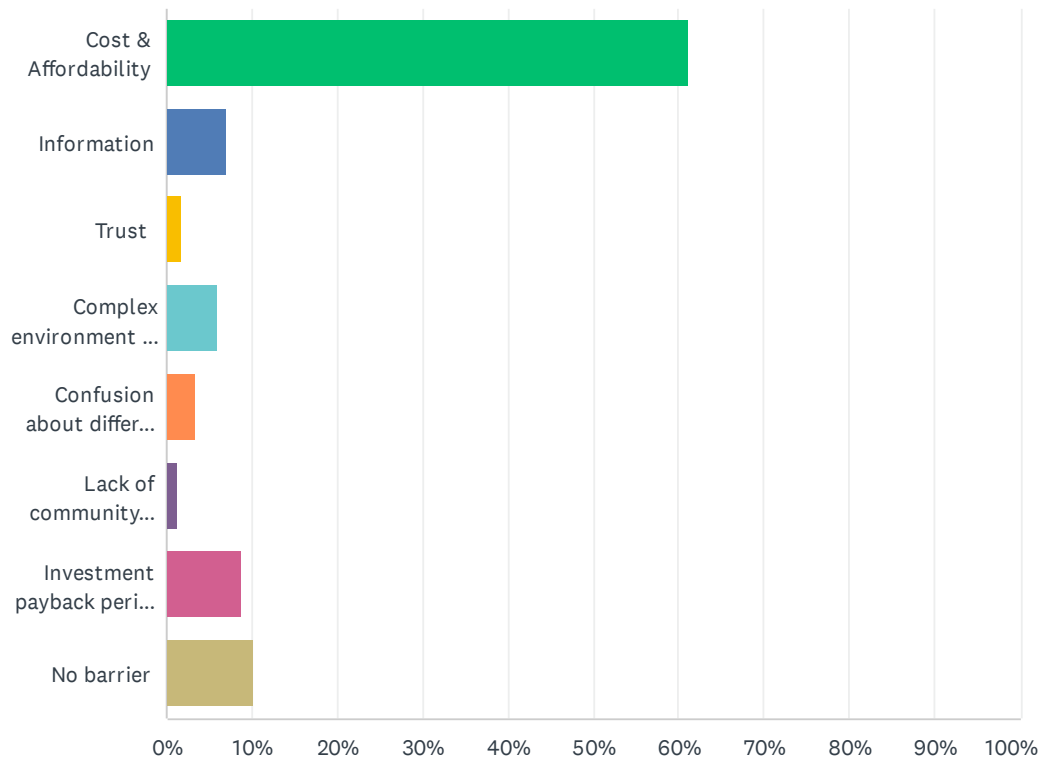

Q14 What is the main barrier for you getting access to battery storage?

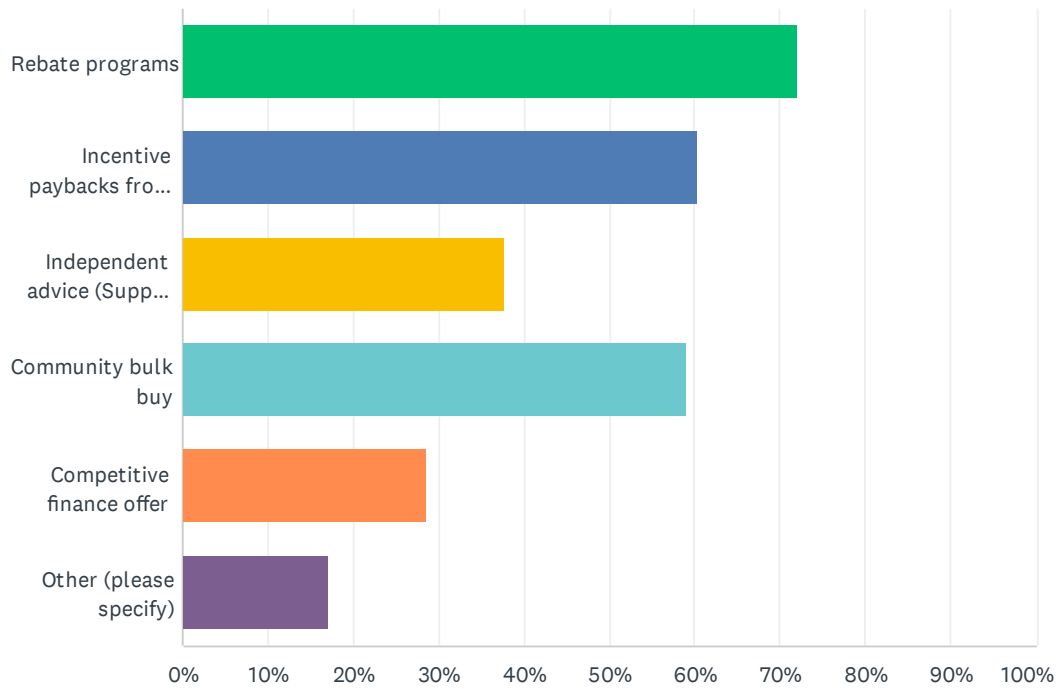

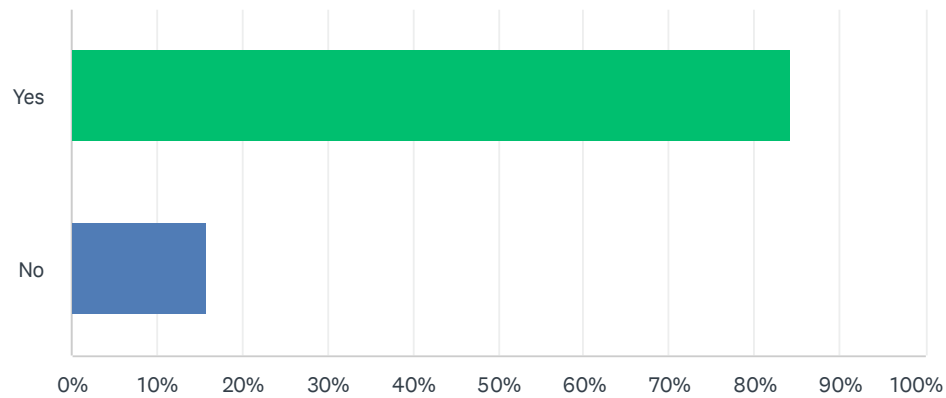

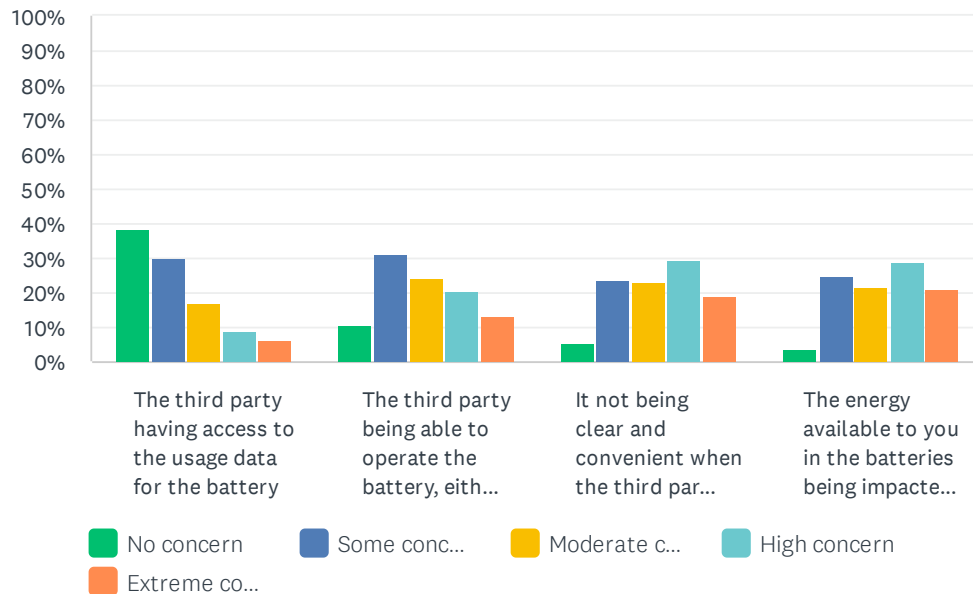

Q17 If there were financial incentives available and a third party, such as a grid operator or energy retailer, had access to a battery at your home, how concerned are you about the following:

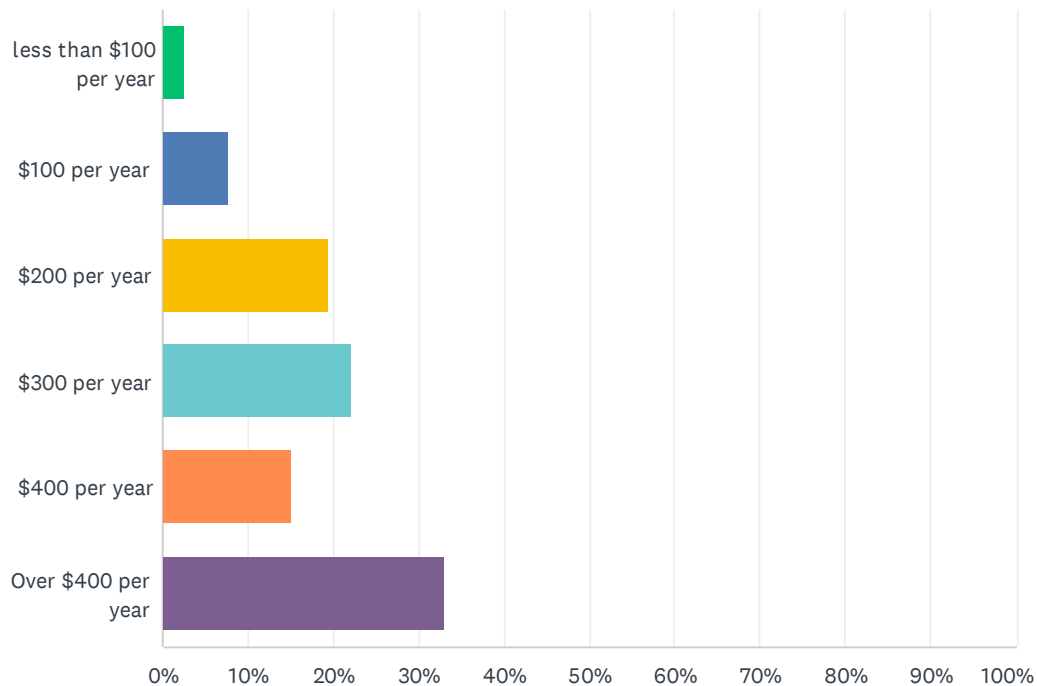

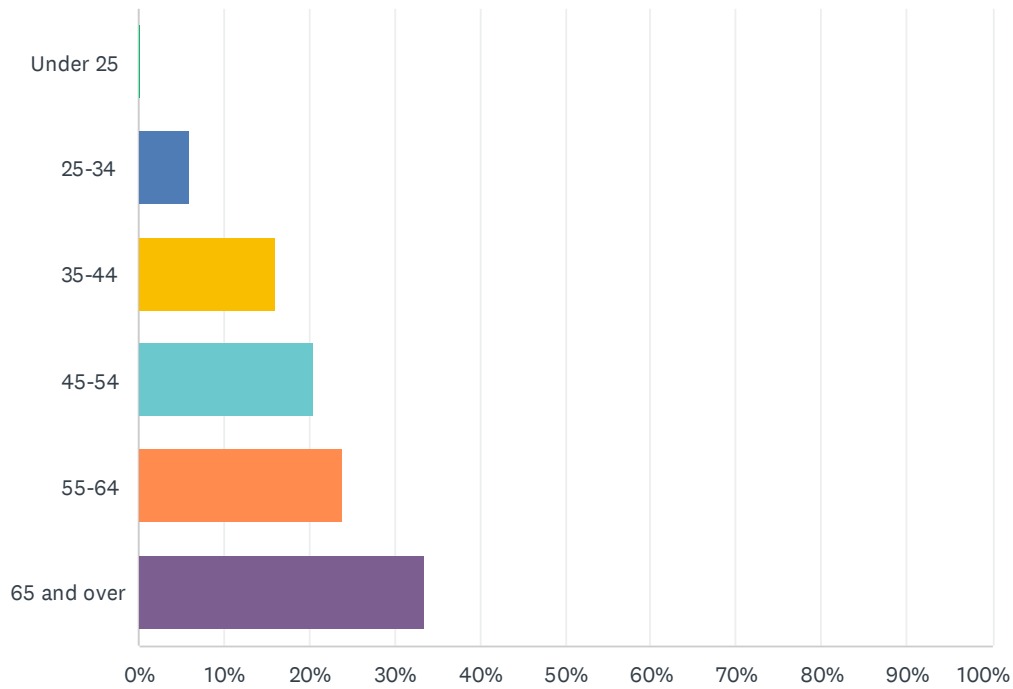

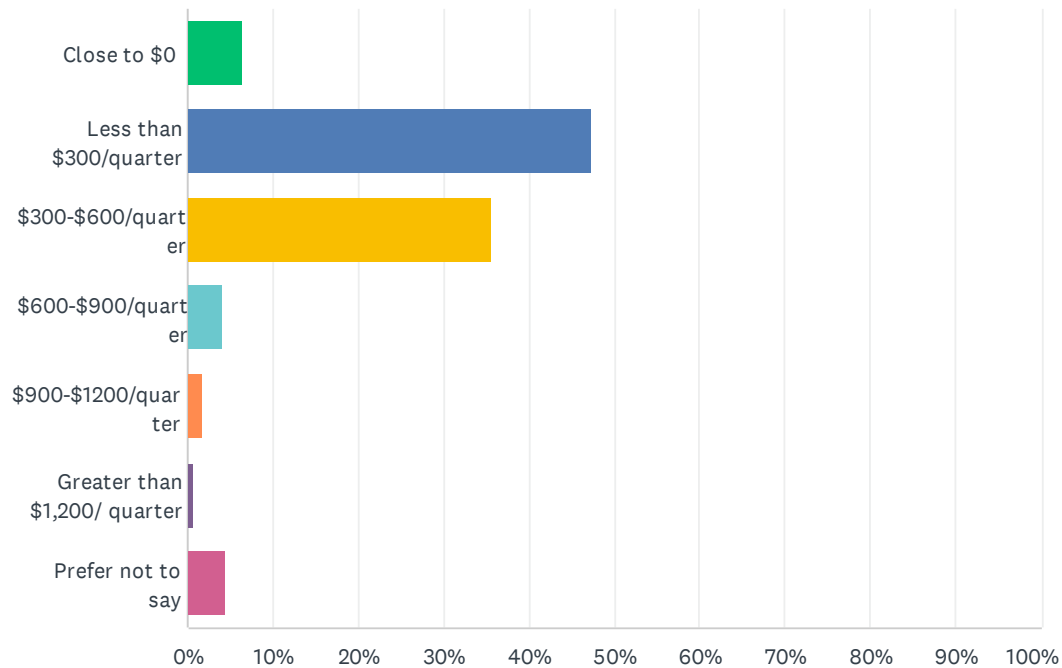

Q22 What is your quarterly electricity bill?

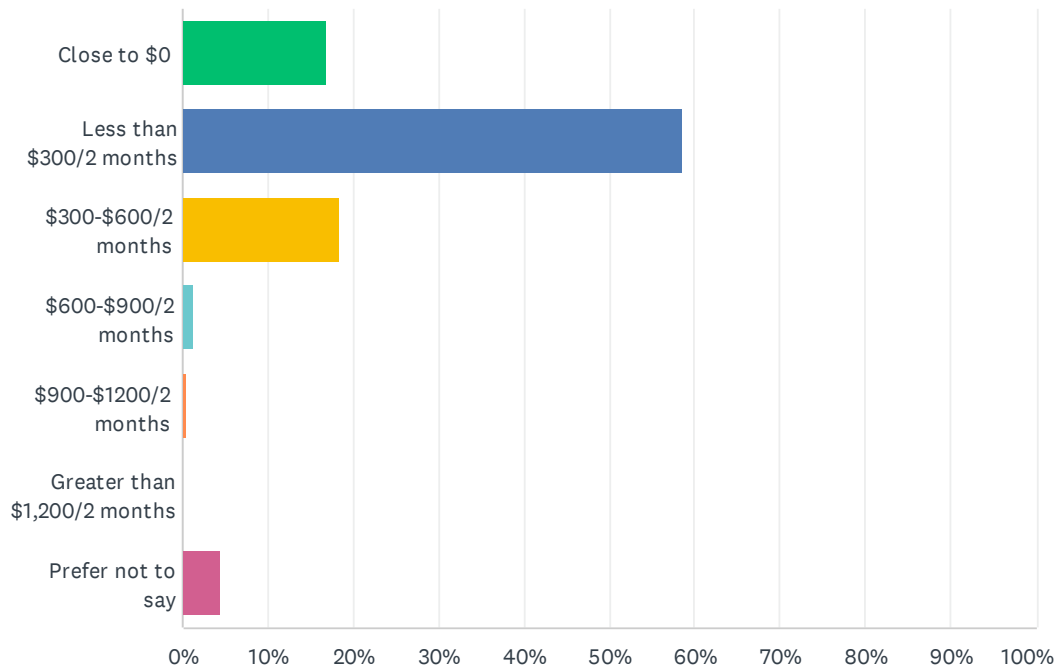
